CHALLENGE TWO

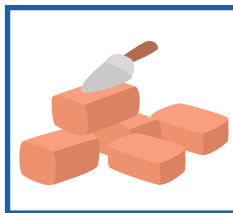
Some of the letters from the words below have gone missing. Can you help by completing the words with the missing letters? Look at the picture to give you a clue for each word.
