Do you like chocolate

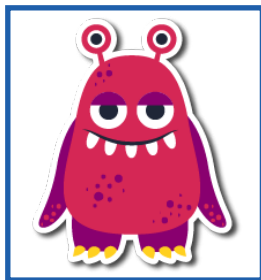
What an amazing achievement, congratulations Sabrina
